



Berry Head Escape



Beginning quietly at Trawler Lights, this romantic coastal walk follows winding clifftop paths towards the wild beauty of Berry Head, where open skies, sea air, and dramatic headlands create one of South Devon's most breathtaking hidden escapes. Along the way, peaceful coves, distant sailing boats, and the sound of the waves far below bring a slower rhythm to the coastline, while the old Napoleonic fortifications stand silently watching over the bay as they have for centuries.

Route Highlights



Berry Head Nature Reserve

Dramatic cliff-top scenery with sweeping views across Torbay and the open coastline.



Coastal Path Views

Open sea air, rugged coastline, and some of Brixham's most breathtaking walking scenery.



Historic Napoleonic Fort

A quiet reminder of Berry Head's maritime and military past overlooking the bay.



Wildlife & Sea Birds

A peaceful stretch of coastline rich with nature, sea birds, and seasonal wildflowers.



Brixham Harbour Finish

End the walk beside the harbour with marina views, cafés, and a relaxed waterside lunch.

Trawler Lights Tip: Bring water, wear comfortable shoes, and don't forget your camera!
