Dartmouth Harbour

A relaxed riverside setting filled with sailing boats, ferries, and waterfront cafés.

Bayard's Cove

A historic waterside corner where Dartmouth's maritime past still quietly lingers.



Foss Street

One of Dartmouth's most charming streets, lined with independent shops and Devon character.



Woodland and steam railway

Follow leafy paths to the sound of the steam train as it winds through the Dart valley.



The Embankment

A gentle waterfront promenade perfect for slow wandering beside the river.
