When William of Orange landed at Brixham with an army of around 15,000 men, he set in motion the events that would become known as the Glorious Revolution. His arrival challenged King James II and helped establish the constitutional monarchy that shaped modern Britain.

Today, a statue overlooking Brixham Harbour marks the spot where he first stepped ashore. Standing there, it is remarkable to think that one quiet Devon fishing town became the stage for a moment that changed a nation.
